## The Vanderbilt Prize in Biomedical Science 2008 Nomination Form

**Purpose of the Vanderbilt Prize in Biomedical Science:** Women have made significant contributions to the science of medicine. For society to benefit from the promise of biomedical research, we must engage women in basic and clinical investigation, nurture their careers, and attract the most capable individuals. The Vanderbilt Prize in Biomedical Science honors and recognizes a woman scientist of national reputation who has a stellar record of research accomplishments and is known for her mentorship of other women in science. The Vanderbilt Prize also nurtures the career, research, and studies of a promising woman beginning her MD/PhD studies at Vanderbilt. The Vanderbilt Prize includes a \$25,000 cash award to the recipient and a funded scholarship named for that year's prize winner to support a woman MD/PhD student at Vanderbilt. The recipient will be expected to give a lecture at Vanderbilt and to serve on the scholarship awardee's thesis committee.

**Eligibility:** Nominees for the Vanderbilt Prize must be women scientists in any area of basic or clinical research or clinical practice. The nominee must have a national reputation, a stellar record of research accomplishments, and must be an active mentor of other women in science.

**Nomination Process:** There is no limit to the number of qualified women scientists an institution may nominate. This form must be mailed to the address below **by January 22, 2008**. In addition to this form, please include

- A letter of nomination from the nominee's department chair or dean
- A complete CV
- One letter of recommendation from a distinguished peer in basic or clinical research or in clinical practice
- Please submit one original and 10 copies. Original and copies **MUST** be unstapled on 3-hole punched paper.
